



# Greater Orlando Hunter Jumper Association COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Greater Orlando Hunter Jumper Association (GOHJA) considers the safety, health and wellness of Horses, Exhibitors, Spectators, Staff, and Community our Number One Priority in the face of this unprecedented crisis.

**Please Note:** *All these actions that GOHJA is requiring is in the best interest & safety of who are involved and participate, so please come prepared! See you in the ring!*

## **GOHJA COVID Procedures (REQUIRED):**

### 1) Face Mask or Face Covering:

1. Require a facemask or face covering for all exhibitors, spectators, staff, officials, volunteers, service providers when NOT mounted on a horse.
2. You will need to provide your own masks – Please ensure you have your mask with you at all times, if mounted on a horse please ensure you have a mask in your pocket or on your person.

### 2) While attending a GOHJA horse show we respectfully ask you to follow 6ft Social Distancing protocols, unless you are on a horse.

1. Per USEF guidelines - If an individual needs an accommodation under the American Disabilities Act, please submit the request, along with documentation of the disability and need for accommodation, to [legalrequests@usef.org](mailto:legalrequests@usef.org).
2. We ask trainers to remember that you are responsible for your staff.
3. Trainers are asked to please bring all the same materials and operating protocols that you have implemented in your private barn operation since the Covid-19 pandemic started.
4. Provide no contact thermometers to their staff and require temperature monitoring.
5. Regularly sanitize golf carts, bikes, cars/trucks, stable doors, buckets, light switches and equipment in your barn area including tack, grooming, feeding, stall cleaning materials, etc.

### 3) **Social Media Posting** – Please be mindful with your posting as it reflects directly on how we as an association are prepared and being safe.



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- 4) *How many can come to the ring?* –
  1. Please only bring essential people to the show ring. Trainer, Rider, Groom and Parents (if the rider is a junior) may accompany a horse to the ring. If you are not a junior, you may have one family member accompany you to the show ring. ***Please maintain social distancing at all times.***
- 5) Ribbons & Awards will be available for pick up at a designated area.
- 6) **Show Office Procedures** - We ask that one representative from each barn do all the office related work.
- 7) **Add/Scratch** : Each show day ONE representative may come to the office to pick-up a paper add/scratch for the barn.
